Gavin's Mill, the old water mill from which Milngavie takes its name, is fast becoming one of the popular attractions on the north of Glasgow. The building goes back to the seventeenth century and was a working mill until the 1950s. Now it's found a new lease of life as a Fair Trade shop and café, stocking a wide range of world and local crafts and foods. It continues the heritage of the Balmore Coach House but the more generous proportions of the Mill allow for new products: a lovely range of soft furnishings: rugs, throws and cushions, recycled aluminium bowls, suncatchers, fine art cards, walking and local history books, toys, instruments, children's cardigans from Peru, woven shopping bags from Burma and a fine selection of Highland Stoneware mugs.

The shop also stocks an impressive variety of vegetarian & gluten free food, teas, ground and bean coffee, rarer soft drinks, flavoured chocolate and snacks. We have a must-try range of foods from the pioneer of fair trade in Holland: herbal teas, juices, chocolate sprinkles and curry pastes.

Ideally situated at the meeting of the West Highland Way and the Allander Walkway, this is a great place to enjoy the Spring, to find some original and interesting gifts to browse and to enjoy the home baking, homemade vegetarian and vegan soups, or oatcakes and cheese in the café, even sitting outside on warmer days on the patio, by the river. Gavin's Mill is situated by the underpass in Tesco car park, a short walk from Milngavie Station.
